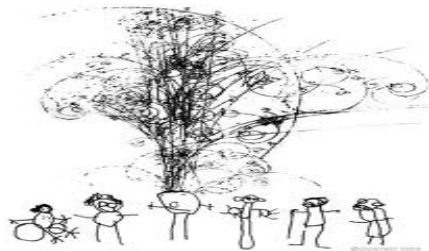


H.O.P.E.
